

Bible bit Genesis 45:1–15

Joseph's brothers went to Egypt in search of food, not family.
Although Joseph recognised them, they didn't recognise
Pharaoh's senior minister. When he eventually admitted who he was, he did so neither as slave, nor high official, but as a brother.

Joseph had clearly matured in many ways. He understood the bigger picture and was confident that God was in control of events all along. We have no sense of him harbouring bitterness or even a grudge. He wanted his wider family to join him in Egypt. Throughout the rest of the story we see hints of the brothers wondering if Joseph would seek revenge — but he never did.
